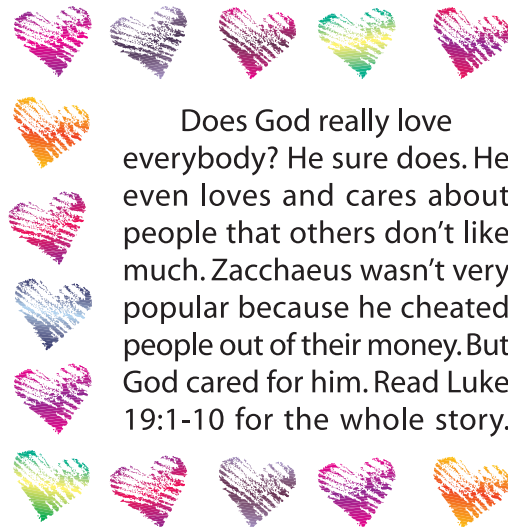


# God so loved you!
