

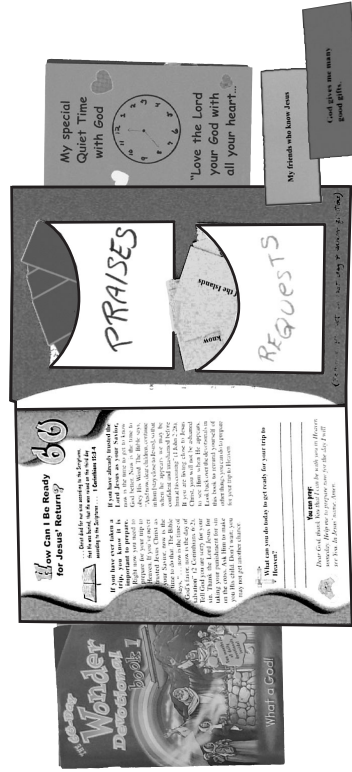
## "QUIET TIME POCKET" INSTRUCTIONS

Here is an idea to encourage children to grow in prayer. Use it with the excellent Bible teaching in *The 60-Day Wonder Devotional Book* or adapt it to any devotional guide you provide for your students.

Enlist an adult Sunday school class or missionary group in your church to make the basic pockets. Have the children do as much as time will allow; e.g., Praise and Request pockets, stickers, door hanger.

1. Cover these instructions and photocopy this page on bright green 8 1/2" x 11" card stock.
2. Cut curved side.
3. Fold page in half and tape short ends.
4. Seal flap on a letter-size envelope; then cut the envelope in half. Cut curves as shown to form two small pockets.
5. With colored markers print PRAISES on one envelope pocket and REQUESTS on the other. Glue pockets to plain side of green Q. T. Pocket.
6. Slip Q. T. Pocket over the back cover of *The Wonder Devotional Book*.
7. Discuss with your children the time they want to meet with God each day and have them draw hands on clock.
8. Give children a Praise and Request slip each week to add to the small pockets. Discuss in class how they can praise and pray for each item. (See booth 22 for slips.)
