

## Does your family sometimes have problems getting along?

## I-Love-You!

## God wants you to forgive each other ♥ Here's an idea to help you do it.

- 1. Using an empty tissue box, make an I-love-you box for your room. First write your name in the blank on the first label below. Then decorate both labels, cut them out and glue them to the sides of your box.
- 2. Fill the box with slips of blank paper.
- 3. If someone in your family makes you upset, pull out one of the papers. Don't write down what they did wrong! Remember 1 Corinthians 13:5 says, "[Love] keeps no record of wrongs." Instead, write "I love you!" on it. As you hold the slip, tell God why you're upset and ask Him to help you forgive the person you're mad at. Ask Him to help you show love to that person in return for what he or she did to you. Put the I-love-you! slip on your family member's pillow.
- 4. If you run out of slips, make some more to keep your "I Love You Box" going.
