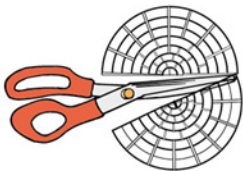


Materials: 1 3"-round plastic canvas, 6½" lengths of plastic craft lace in rainbow colors, 1" magnet strip, 1" strip white construction paper same width as



magnet, scissors, glue gun.

Directions: Cut canvas in half. One half will be slightly smaller when you trim the edges. Count 6 rows from the outer edge then cut off extra rows in the center to create rainbow shape. Weave plastic lace through holes of each row—1 color per row.



Start on the same side of canvas each time.

Peel off white backing from magnet and attach white construction paper. (Without paper the black magnet shows through.) Attach magnet to back of rainbow with glue gun.

Use the rainbow to reinforce teaching on God's promises. Have children name one promise for each color then thank God for His faithfulness. The rainbow can also hold memory verse tokens or other class work on the child's refrigerator.
