



Materials per child: Craft foam—red: 3½" x 2", two "smile" shapes cut from white (3½" x ½") and dark green (3½" x ¼"); daisy flower paper punch/yellow card stock; ink pen; craft glue; 3 real watermelon seeds cleaned/dried (or tear-shaped seeds cut from black craft foam); 1½" x ½" self-adhesive magnetic tape; scissors; resealable plastic bag.



Directions before class: 1. Make a card stock pattern for each craft foam piece. 2. Round the corners of two sides of the red foam to resemble half a watermelon. Cut out a small "bite" along the top if desired. 3. Punch a daisy blossom from yellow card stock. 4. Place foam pieces, flower blossom, seeds and magnet into plastic bag.

Instructions to complete Watermelon Magnet Craft:

1. Center the magnet onto the back of the red piece.
2. Turn the red piece over to begin layering the white and green pieces.
3. Line the curved edge of the red piece with glue, then place white piece on glued area.
4. Glue green piece along the edge of the white piece. Glue blossom onto rind.
5. Glue seeds into the center of watermelon.

To use: Give each child a watermelon magnet craft kit with instructions and craft supplies. As they complete their kit share the plan of salvation, using the colors as they correspond to the *Wordless Book*.
