



Material per child: 2 sheets of 5½" x 8½" card stock (1 red, 1 white), 4" and 3½" heart patterns, 3½" square red card stock, colored pens, pencil, thread, transparent tape, heart stickers, scissors, (optional: Bible references from step 6 below printed on self-adhesive labels). Directions

1. Place 4" pattern in center of 1 sheet of red card stock, trace and cut out heart. Place this sheet over white sheet; trace heart and cut out.

- 2. On the white card stock sheet, carefully cut 2 slits, approximately 1½" at the top and bottom of *heart opening* as shown.
- 3. On the red sheet cut 2 slits, approximately 1½" from the *top* and *bottom edge* of sheet.
- 4. Trace and cut 3½" heart from red card stock square. (Optional: Cut a smaller heart from light-colored card stock and glue it to



the center of red heart.)

5. Position 3½" heart in the center of the red card. Tape 1½" piece of thread to heart and top of opening so it hangs in center.



6. Decorate card and write a Valentine's
Day greeting with colored pens.
Print a Bible reference about love
on each side of card: Jeremiah

31:3; Romans 8:38-39; 1 Peter 4:8; John 14:15; 1 John 4:8; 1 Corinthians 13:4-7; Matthew 22:37; Jeremiah 29:13.

7. Gently interlock slits and stand card up.

*To use:* Give card to parents and tell them to read a love verse from the Bible each day.
