This energetic review game is great for movement.

Directions

Use a jump rope to make a large circle. Let children (up to 10 kids may fit inside) who think they can say the verse jump into the circle at the same time and repeat the verse in unison. (This can be done with or without the verse visual.) Every time a group successfully repeats the verse the rest of the group claps heartily. This recognizes the kids inside the circle as winners because they learned God's Word.



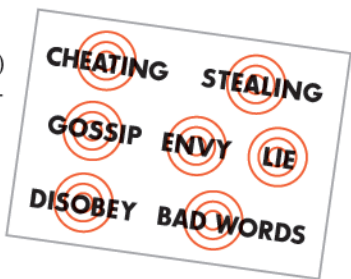

SNOWBALL THROW REVIEW

Materials: 2 spongy water balls ("splash bombs") from a discount store, 1 sheet posterboard, marker.

Directions: In advance soak balls in water and squeeze out most of the water. Refrigerate balls for several hours, list sins in large letters on posterboard (lie, cheat, disobey, say bad words, gossip, envy, etc.).

To play: Form a circle around the posterboard. Explain that God's Word has power to help us fight sin. Review the verse. After the first child says the verse he may try to hit one of the listed sins on the poster with the "snowball" (water ball). (The wet ball will leave a mark.) The second child to say the verse may throw the snowball. The process repeats until all the words on the poster have been bombarded.
