
*Materials:* card stock in various colors, scissors, glue, stapler, photocopies of window, tomb and Christ or have children draw and color figures of Christ and the tomb.

*Directions:* The key to this craft is that the page of each scene is progressively longer, beginning with the shortest page on top.

Page 1—A 10" x 9" sheet of bright-colored card stock showing a 4-sectioned window. Children will cut out sections and print *He Is Alive!* at the top.



Page 2—Jesus standing on one side of 10½" x 3" green strip. Cut slits along top for grassy effect.

Page 3—Empty tomb placed on the opposite side of an 11" x 6" brown strip.

Page 4—On the upper third of a 12" x 9" sheet of blue art paper, use crayons to draw a hill, 3 crosses and sky.

To assemble the diorama stack all the pages in order with the left sides and lower edges even. Staple the layers on left side. Pull the right sides together so they are even and staple to complete the diorama. Let your class review the Easter story then repeat *He is alive!* several times.
