



*Materials:* Art paper—full sheets of black and pieces of red, white and gray; white crayons; scissors; glue stick; border; (*optional:* self-adhesive magnets).

*Directions:* Use black art paper to make a “chalkboard.” Print the current memory verse on it with white crayon. Cut an apple from red paper, a piece of chalk from white and a chalkboard eraser from gray paper. Draw a line at the bottom of the chalkboard and glue the

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chalk, eraser and apple in place. A border can be drawn with crayons or colored chalk or added from scrap paper. (*Optional:* Add self-adhesive magnets.) Tell children to place the chalkboard on the refrigerator as a reminder of God’s lesson for them to learn this week.
