



Objects: Spider web made from wire hanger, black yarn (approx. 5 yds.), 2 black pom poms (1 large/1 small), 1 black chenille stem, 2 small plastic moveable eyes, craft glue, paper clips, transparent tape, paper, fine felt-tip marker, scissors.

Directions: Remove the end from hanger. Bend the hanger into a spider web shape with 6-8 points. Tie yarn onto one of the points, wrap it around the wire and cross over to the opposite point, wrap it around the wire, knot it several times and trim ends. Repeat this step for each point. In the center of the web wrap the yarn around each "spoke," working around to the outside. Tie off the end.

Glue eyes onto the small pom pom (spider head), then glue it onto the large pom pom (body). Cut chenille stem into 4 sections (3" legs). Twist sections together twice in the middle then fold in half to make 8 legs. Separate legs. Glue the center of folded stems to the bottom of large pom pom. Attach spider to the web.

On slips of paper print: *Video Games, Heroes, Drugs, Smoking, TV, Alcohol, Books/Magazines, Music, Internet, Wrong Crowd, Fashion, Fear of Witnessing*. Tape the long end of a paper clip to the back of each slip of paper. Slightly bend the short ends outward to hang words on the web.

Scripture: Colossians 3:22-23

Lesson: (*Show spider web.*) What is different about this spider web? (*It has words.*) We will read one word or phrase at time and talk about how it can cause you to sin. When you sin it is like being caught in Satan's web. Think of a way to not sin and we will remove the word from the web. For example, you sin when you watch too much TV and don't get your homework done. How can you not get caught in Satan's web? (*Complete homework before watching TV.*)
