## Wonderzone.com®

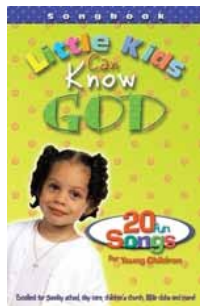
Wonderzone is CEF's internet ministry. This discipleship and evangelism tool has Bible stories, missionary stories, devotionals, games and many other activities for young children.

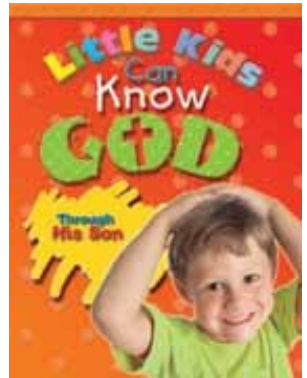

The gift of teaching is bestowed by God, strengthened by teaching techniques (pedagogical knowledge) and validated by the edification of the body of Christ. Knowledge of the subject matter is learned through prayerful study.

In order to assist in the training of aspiring, beginning and experienced Sunday School teachers, CEF Singapore offers a number of topics.

We suggest a "mix of topics" that includes the following:

- The imparting of vision
- Understanding children
- Content knowledge (i.e., the Bible)
- Teaching techniques
- Practical classroom management
