Beyond Singapore

When we were first asked to conduct training for the students at Chin Lien Seminary, we were excited because many of their students are from China and there is a commitment that they would go back home to continue their ministry. This was too good an opportu-

nity to let it pass by – an opportunity to reach and teach children in China vicariously through their graduates.

Since then our Education and Training Coordinator, Ms Lorita Lim, Singapore Christian Evangelistic League (SCEL) Trainer, Pastor Xiao Dan and trainers from CEF Taiwan had trained 43 students. We conducted Teaching Children Effectively Level 1 (TCE 1), Level 2 (TCE 2) and Instructor of Teachers (IOT 1) training. The IOT 1 certified their graduates to conduct TCE 1.

Our Regional Education Consultant, Ms Jan Johnson and the trainers from CEF Taiwan were impressed by the teachers in the IOT 1 course – their teachers are effective communicators and teachers of the Word of God.

We understand that TCE 1 and TCE 2 conducted locally are carried out under the umbrella of the Singapore Christian Evangelistic League. As part of the TCE requirements, students are required to teach five children's classes applying the principles and methodologies learned in the course. Their students are fulfilling their requirements in the local churches and student centres.

We look forward to hear reports of their graduates' ministry of reaching and teaching children in China as well as equipping more teachers to do the same. To God be the glory!
