



DAILY READING:
Luke 8:23-24

It was dark outside. Thunder crashed! Lightening flashed across the sky! Have you ever been afraid during a storm? Big storms can be dangerous!

LUKE 8:23-24 And as they sailed he fell asleep. And a windstorm came down on the lake, and they were filling with water and were in danger. ²⁴And they went and woke him, saying, "Master, Master, we are perishing!" And he awoke and rebuked the wind and the raging waves, and they ceased, and there was a calm.



THINK ABOUT IT!

Jesus' disciples were fishermen. They were used to storms on the lake. Why do you think this storm was a problem?

The boat Jesus and the disciples were in was small. If waves swept over it, water would rush into the boat. They were in danger of sinking in the big lake. Jesus was asleep but the disciples were scared! What kinds of things make you afraid?

God's Word says that as long as you are in the world you will have problems (John 16:33). Jesus knows about your problems and how frightening they can be. He wants you to trust Him. Because He is with you, you can have peace instead of fear, even during the problems. He can keep you calm and quiet on the inside. How do you think having peace instead of fear will help you face a problem better?
