John 11:1-6

How do you feel when things go wrong? Maybe you wonder, “If God loves me so much, why did He let that happen?” Two women in the Bible must have felt that way.

JOHN 11:1, 3-4 Now a certain man was ill, Lazarus of Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha...³So the sisters sent to him, saying, “Lord, he whom you love is ill.” ⁴But when Jesus heard it he said, “This illness does not lead to death. It is for the glory of God, so that the Son of God may be glorified through it.”

The sisters sent a message to Jesus. What did they say about their brother Lazarus?

In verse four what reason did the Lord Jesus give that Lazarus was sick?
